MINERAL EXPORT EARNINGS FOR QUARTER ONE: JANUARY-MARCH 2023

Rwanda Mines, Petroleum and Gas Board (RMB) hereby announces the mineral export revenues for the first quarter of 2023, covering the period from January to March. The quarterly earnings are USD 247,480,699.40. The performance of different commodities in terms of value in USD are as follows:

- Cassiterite generated 316,093 Kilograms worth USD 5,436,480 in January, 320,555 Kilograms worth USD 5,398,054 in February, and 363,701 Kilograms worth USD 5,903,483 in March.
- Coltan has demonstrated a substantial increase in export revenues, reaching 124,514 Kilograms worth USD 5,911,646 in January, 138,205 Kilograms worth USD 6,985,467 in February, and 213,065 Kilograms worth USD 11,415,082 in March.
- Wolfram generated 129,407 Kilograms worth USD 1,723,665 in January, 211,449 Kilograms worth USD 2,973,988 in February, and 231,844 Kilograms worth USD 3,261,757 in March.
- Gold generated 870 Kilograms worth USD 53,234,196.20 in January, 745 Kilograms worth USD 46,529,585.80 in February, and 1,465 Kilograms worth USD 90,519,870 in March.
- Other Minerals have also contributed 2,545,274 Kilograms worth USD 5,103,373.9 in January, 500,971 Kilograms worth USD 872,301.6 in February, and 827,041 Kilograms worth USD 2,211,749 in March.

From January to March 2023, the volume in KGs of minerals exported is 5,925,199 and values in USD is 247,480,699.40.
