MINERAL EXPORT EARNINGS FOR QUARTER THREE: JULY-SEPTEMBER 2023

Rwanda Mines, Petroleum and Gas Board (RMB) hereby announces the mineral export revenues for the third quarter of 2023, covering the period from July to September. The quarterly earnings are USD 241,823,194. The performance of different commodities in terms of value in USD are as follows:

- Cassiterite generated 294,717 Kilograms worth USD 5,367,704 in July, 415,482 Kilograms worth USD 6,906,567 in August, and 440,176 Kilograms worth USD 6,783,099 in September.
- Coltan generated 189,183 Kilograms worth USD 8,145,587 in July, 141,658 Kilograms worth USD 5,827,562 in August, and 208,155 Kilograms worth USD 9,313,654 in September.
- Wolfram generated 237,116 Kilograms worth USD 3,040,783 in July, 198,409 Kilograms worth USD 2,663,971 in August, and 218,802 Kilograms worth USD 2,711,206 in September.
- Gold generated 1,155 Kilograms worth USD 73,181,036 in July, 1,000 Kilograms worth USD 62,156,101 in August, and 845 Kilograms worth USD 52,676,671 in September.
- Other Minerals have also contributed 1,210,458 Kilograms worth USD 1,085,647 in July, 1,219,670 Kilograms worth USD 1,249,889 in August, and 739,711 Kilograms worth USD 713,714 in September.

From July to September 2023, the volume in KGs of minerals exported is 5,516,538 and values in USD is 241,823,194 which is a 22.4% increase compared to the same period last year when it generated 4,321,566 KGs worth USD 197,496,029.
