



## COMMUNIQUÉ

### **MINERAL EXPORT EARNINGS FOR QUARTER TWO: APRIL-JUNE 2023**

Rwanda Mines, Petroleum and Gas Board (RMB) hereby announces the mineral export revenues for the second quarter of 2023, covering the period from April to June. The quarterly earnings are USD 362,368,845. The performance of different commodities in terms of value in USD are as follows:

- Cassiterite generated 388,818 Kilograms worth USD 6,210,054 in April, 341,533 Kilograms worth USD 5,202,418 in May, and 413,804 Kilograms worth USD 7,400,529 in June.
- Coltan generated 133,828 Kilograms worth USD 6,296,903 in April, 198,787 Kilograms worth USD 9,587,723 in May, and 254,400 Kilograms worth USD 11,930,212 in June.
- Wolfram generated 120,920 Kilograms worth USD 1,574,123 in April, 246,920 Kilograms worth USD 3,335,391 in May, and 267,595 Kilograms worth USD 3,579,145 in June.
- Gold generated 1,506 Kilograms worth USD 97,553,111 in April, 1,520 Kilograms worth USD 99,039,329 in May, and 1,670 Kilograms worth USD 106,100,444 in June.
- Other Minerals have also contributed 514,820 Kilograms worth USD 1,233,420 in April, 1,357,729 Kilograms worth USD 1,327,094 in May, and 2,394,688 Kilograms worth USD 1,998,947 in June.

From April to June 2023, the volume in KGs of minerals exported is 6,638,538, and values in USD is 362,368,845.
